ARK TESTING:

- The testing window is April 15 through April 25, 2024.
 - There is no additional window for make-up testing so please plan on testing at the beginning of the window to allow time for make-up testing at the end.
- All students in grades 2 through 12 will be required to take the assessment.
 - It is at the discretion of the principal whether or not to also test the faculty/staff.
- The assessment can be administered in one class period. See the approximate testing times below.
 - 2nd/3rd grade: 25-30 minutes
 - High school: 45-50 minutes

STEP UP: Step Up has begun their Open Enrollment process for new and renewal Private School, Personalized Education Program and Unique Abilities scholarships for 2024-2025!

For NEW applicants, please <u>download this guide</u> to create an EMA account. **PLEASE NOTE**: You MUST add all new students to your account before submitting your application.

STEP UP SCHOLARSHIP: Important Changes -

- 1. New and renewal applications are open this year at the same time, with priority given to renewal applications.
- 2. **Any child turning 3 within the 2024-2025 school year** with a disability can apply for the FES-UA scholarship (without the September 1st restriction).
- 3. Residency requirements and documents have changed AND only one guardian information will be required.
- 4. Due to new legislation, preschool students attending a school that does not accept VPK or School Readiness, can still use their scholarship for FES-UA if the preschool is attached to a compliant elementary school.

Test Scores - Schools may have recently received a communication from the Learning Systems Institute at Florida State University who is responsible for collecting test score information for the evaluation of the Florida Tax Credit (FTC) and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO) programs.

As a reminder, private schools are required by law to report the scores of participating students in grades 3 to 10 on a Florida Department of Education-approved test to the Learning Systems Institute. More information on this requirement can be found here.

SUMMATIVE EVALUATION: Attached are the slides from the Teacher Evaluator presentation focusing on the summative evaluations through Rediker. These evaluations need to be completed prior to contracts. If you have any questions, reach out to bcummings@theadom.org.
