Overview of PACS in 2022-2023

- Bylaws and Role of Members

- Principals' Meeting on August 2

- New Teacher Orientation on August 9
 - Comments: wonderful event, all topics covered, sense of larger community, evident the difference between being a teacher and a catholic school teacher, and positive responses from new teachers
 - Discussed continuing event next year. It makes sense to do it the day before the teachers start. Will wait until calendar comes out.
 - May do a compressed version later in the year during an early dismissal day to catch any teachers who missed or were hired late.

School Safety Training

- Discussed quick response systems, Safer Watch, ...
- Consider putting together an ADOM (Archdiocese of Miami) safety committee. Everyone agreed that there would be value in that.

School Calendars

- Some discrepancies as OCS has collected and reviewed calendars: Delayed start (PK), 9 extra 1pm dismissals, 22- noon dismissals, dismissal at 11am, early 8th grade promotion ceremonies
- Concern: Loss of instructional time and scholarship compliance
- 8th Grade promotion ceremony cannot be earlier than June 2
- The last day for PK-8 is June 9 (If an 8th grader is not in attendance, they are to be marked absent.)
- May not move teacher workdays (start and end dates)

Elementary Behavior Matrix

- Matrix was distributed via email
- Matrix is for 6th-8th graders ONLY
- The matrix are recommendations with reasonable responses to challenging behaviors.
- Definitions are included
- The only mandates are the red "C" which means to call the superintendent
- The document does not have final approval yet. ALL recommendations or input is appreciated.
- Recommendations: posting violent images should include a call to the superintendent
- Some discretion in the matrix
- The matrix is an administrative tool NOT for classroom behavior response.
- Do not share the matrix yet. Share additional feedback before it is rolled out. Looking to send out in October.
- Principal is sharing with OCS a Discipline Referral Flow Chart

Requests for a system-wide blanket forgiveness policy for teachers with children at other schools to remain free in the aftercare program.

Dr. Rigg has not given up on a system-wide tuition discount.

Educational Policy Revision – Questions and Discussion

- Revision this fall. We know that some policies need to be reviewed.
- Feedback: honor roll, question regarding weighting (they can determine at the school level), homework and grading (no policy about no homework), appreciate having the manual for continuity, minutes
- Homework should enhance the learning process
- High School Feedback: has an issue with nothing less than a 50 on the report card and has concerns that it gives them a wrong impression of reality, question about taking the .5 virtual requirement during the school day
- Will discuss 50% grading policy at the high school cohort meeting

Principal Topics

- Policy regarding courses that are approved by the school when taking ADOM VCS classes.
 Discussion ensued. Will discuss at the high school cohort meeting.
- Concerns about cost of Play Like a Champion and communication
- Communication regarding athletics
- Google Summit was excellent
- Concerns about pulling teachers out of schools for meetings
- Statistics report is being put electronically. The due date cannot change.
- Discussed disqualification list
- Catechist courses- Not all courses are offered every semester. Only specific courses will be offered each semester. (Requested to discuss in cohort meeting.)
- Faculty retreats can count as renewal points, but must be preapproved by Sr. Karen.
- FES-UA can be funded at any time.
