

POLICY

Special collections required in each parish of the Diocese shall be defined annually by the Bishop. In addition, the Bishop may add emergency appeals to meet the needs of the local or universal Church.

Special collections required of each parish fulfill the responsibilities of the Diocese for the support of the Church's local, national, and international works of charity and education. Every parish should permit and encourage a full opportunity for people to participate in the appeal supported by each Special Collection. The focus of each collection emphasizes the worldwide communion with the poor, the underprivileged, and the needy.

The collections established for this Diocese shall be defined annually by the Bishop (as defined in Canon 1266) and published, at his direction, by the Diocesan Finance Office.

On a periodic basis the Bishop will send the pastor information and bulletin inserts in support of each special collection. Many other appeals are received by the



Bishop. Occasionally certain appeals and emergencies appear that are especially worthy and the Bishop will bring them to the attention of the pastor and his people with a request for their support.

These Special collections must be accounted for as restricted funds in the parish's financial reporting system, and not as offertory or other income which is subject to general assessment. In addition, parishes must remit them to the Diocesan Finance Office within ten (10) business days of the scheduled collection date. Contributions from all parishes in the Diocese are then sent to the beneficiary of the collection.
