Dear Principals,

With the start of July, we are now officially in the 2025/26 school year. I look forward to our efforts ahead as we prepare for the start of classes next month. We are truly "on good ground" in Catholic education in the Archdiocese of Miami!

We continue to monitor changes in federal funds and their potential impact on our Catholic schools. Most urgently, we are in close communication with our contacts in Washington regarding the current pause in the release of funds from Titles II-IV. We hope this issue will be resolved quickly, particularly ahead of the start of the new school year. We are also following the passage of federal tax credit scholarships (i.e. ECCA). While there is much still to learn about this new effort, remember that the scholarships would not begin for a full school year (until the 2026/27).

In the end, this is proving to be an eventful summer! We will continue to distribute communications and announcements as more information is known.

Let us pray for those affected by recent natural disasters, particularly those impacted by the flooding in Texas.

- You'll also want to compile a list of teachers and class rosters.

If you would like to download or print any historical data, **please do so before August 14**th. Historical data from 2024/25 will not be available on the dashboard.
