ATHLETICS:

PLAY LIKE A CHAMPION TODAY

Physical Education instructional materials for grade schools must be ordered by September 24, 2024. The curriculum is now divided by grade levels: 5, 6, 7, 8. Instructional objectives are progressive. Interdisciplinary instruction (Phys Ed & Religion) is encouraged.

Parent training (for parents of participating athletes) is required. Schools must maintain records of parent training.

Coach's training is required. No coach - - - volunteer or paid - - - my begin coaching students until they complete the training.

Dade County grade school coaches' training is scheduled for August 20 and September 3 at St. Theresa School at 5:30 pm. **Broward County training** is scheduled for September 4 at St. Ambrose School at 6:00 pm.

ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ATHLETIC HANDBOOK will be promulgated during fall semester.

Athletic Directors should review the handbook with all coaches and each coach should sign the Athletic Handbook Affirmation Form as well as the, the ADOM Security Plan (which confirms that they have reviewed the Athletic Program EOP) and the Athletic Supervising Assignment.

Reporting protocol for emergencies during athletic events: Call 911, Athletic Director, Principal, Moderator, Superintendent (or designee)

Athletic Directors' Meeting for grade school AD's will be held at Monsignor Pace High School form 12:00 – 3:00 on August 7, 2024.

CERTIFICATION:

Certification and RML Training for Certification Coordinators: We will be hosting an online certification and RML training class on August 8th at 1:00PM for certification coordinators. This training is for all educators who are responsible for implementing and administering i-Ready in the 2024-2025 school year.

NEW TEACHER ORIENTATION:

Remember that all teachers who are new to the Archdiocese <u>must</u> attend the New Teacher Orientation on Aug. 5 at Monsignor Pace High School (8:30 AM-12:30 PM). This includes teachers with prior experience outside of the Archdiocese (i.e. in public schools, other dioceses, etc.). New teachers of all subjects and grade levels should attend.
