Scholarship Application Dates for Private School Scholarship and Unique Abilities end on November 15, 2025. The deadline for parental acceptance is December 15, 2025.

Exceptions are:

- Dependents of active-duty U.S. Armed Forces members
- Dependent children of law enforcement officers (FES-UA only)
- Students in foster care or out-of-home care
- Students facing bullying or harassment at public school

PROFESSIONAL MENTORING PROGRAM (PMP):

The deadline for PMP registration is October 1, 2025. (Feel free to bring the documentation and checks to our upcoming Principals' meeting on September 26).

We will continue following the 2024-2025 PMP Handbook this year. The handbook can be found in **E-Library** under **Education— Schools—Certification**. See the FAQs below. If you still have questions, please email <u>teacher.certification@theadom.org</u>.

- Who should do the PMP?
 - o Only teachers with a current Temporary Certificate in hand.
- How can we tell if a teacher must do the PMP?
 - o By reading the **Statement of Eligibility.** It will read: "Completion of a Florida approved Professional Education Competence Program documented by your employer."
- How do we enroll a teacher?
 - o **By October 1**st, send the completed **Teacher Enrollment Form** (pg. 10), copies of the **Temporary Certificate and SOE**, as well as the \$50.00 fee (a check payable to "ADOM")

- When does the program begin?
 - o October 1st
- What qualifications does the mentor need to have?
 - o Minimum of three (3) years of successful teaching experience in Catholic schools
 - o Professional Certificate
 - o Trained in Clinical Education
- When does the program end?
 - o May 1st
- What do we do when the program is completed?
 - o Send *ONLY* pages 9-27 (PMP Packet) via email to Ana Umana at <u>teacher.certification@theadom.org</u>. You will also be scanning and sending all evidence. The portfolio stays at the school.
- What happens next?
 - o Once the completed program has been sent to the Office of Catholic Schools (OCS) and verified, the OCS will submit the PMP to the FLDOE.
