Data Recognition Corporation (DRC) Testing: Order forms should have been submitted via email attachment to Joseph Walker (contractshelf@datarecognitioncorp.com) and Gabriel Cambert (gcambert@theadom.org) by September 30, 2022.

An email will be sent out soon to the school-site testing coordinators and principals with information on how to prepare the PreCode Files for the spring 2023 administration of the TerraNova3. Please note that the completed CSV file must be submitted by November 1st, 2022 to DRC.

If you are interested in piloting DRC's Beacon (for interim/progress monitoring) or the TerraNova NEXT (an online test for students in grades K–8 who did not take the TerraNova3 in the spring of 2022), please email Christine Kirk at ckirk@datarecognitioncorp.com and copy Gabriel Cambert at gcambert@theadom.org. Both assessments are being offered for free this school year. The TerraNova NEXT must be administered by November 1st, 2022 to ensure the validity of the next spring administration of the TerraNova3. You can begin implementation of the Beacon assessment at any point throughout the school year.

Elementary AP Meeting: As previously announced, the elementary Assistant Principals will be meeting on <u>Wednesday, Nov. 2.</u> Specific times and location will be released closer to the date. Please let your AP know about this meeting so that he/she can mark it on their calendar.

E-Library Login Information: We were recently informed that every school has two unique logins for the E-Library, a general login and an administrative login. The administrative login uses the principal's email address as the username (i.e. gcambert@theadom.org). The general login is the same except with the digit "1" inserted before the @ symbol (i.e. gcambert1@theadom.org).

Using your school's unique credentials should help minimize the login lockouts we have experience due to the excessive failed attempts.

If you do not know the unique login credentials for your school, please email Abel Barrera, the ADOM IT Director, at abarrera@theadom.org and copy Gabriel Cambert, gcambert@theadom.org. They will reset the passwords on the accounts and forward you the new credentials.

FCC Accreditation Support: Our Director of Continuous Improvement, Gabriel Cambert, is available and eager to support you with all your FCC accreditation needs. IDEA Mandatory Meeting: The Archdiocese is partnering with the six other dioceses in Florida and two large Jewish school consortiums to perform a study of the implementation of IDEA services in our state. We are asking each school to send two designated educators to a training. They need only attend <u>one</u> training (you can select the date/location that works best for you). Please see the attached flyer for more information. Specifically, each school should send their ESE Director/Coordinator (or equivalent) as well as a second member of the administration (e.g. principal, assistant principal, counseling director, etc.).
