Three Progress Monitorings (PM1, PM2, and PM3) must be administered to ensure compliance withassessment administration.

FIREARM SIMULATION APPLICATIONS: Recently, the Department's Office of Safe Schools (OSS) learned of two increasingly popular, but potentially dangerous, applications that students can download to their mobile devices and tablets: Weaphones and iGun Pro. These applications are designed to mimic the sound of loading, racking and firing a real firearm. The use of such an application on a school campus could create confusion, fear and hysteria, and put students at risk.

Given the prevalence of mobile phones on school campuses and the fact that these apps are easily accessible to students, we kindly ask that you swiftly notify your district employees, all safe-school officers and local law enforcement agencies about these apps so they are made aware and can advise students not to use them during school and school-related activities.

FROM THE OFFICE OF HUMAN RESOURCES: Please have your facilities staff conduct an inventory of safety signage (such as "Authorized Personnel Only"; "Watch Your Step", and other signage) around your facilities, for the protection of your workers in addition to students and visitors. They should also take the opportunity to critically assess any additional needs in this area.

Also, it's imperative that no unauthorized person removes any safety signage. Workers and volunteers who prepare and decorate rooms for events should not be permitted to remove any safety signage. The removal of safety signage must be preceded by a written request to the principal, who will review the request and substitute another safety measure if the risk still presents itself.
