EARLY CHILDHOOD PERSONNEL: We have heard that some early education teachers and assistants have been having difficulty securing spots to take the necessary tests for credentials and course certificates. DCF personnel have told us that **you should reach out directly to the** <u>Training Coordinating Agency (TCA)</u> (I have attached this list) in your county to discuss any specific needs. The TCAs monitor exam sessions and their capacity and adjust as necessary to help meet the needs of the region. They also said that exam sessions do fill up quickly, and we encourage personnel (teachers) to sign up for exams while they are taking the course. That way their testing date secured in advance.
