

A MESSAGE FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT

Dear Principals,

Although we are still completing the third quarter, we are already making plans for the 2024/25 school year. You should have seen my recent email about next year's Theme ("Angels Among Us"). I know that all schools are also in the midst of enrollment, setting budgets, and making other plans for the coming year. In the OCS, we are in discussion about our potential priorities for 2024/25. A tentative list of these priorities will be discussed with you at our next Principals' Meeting on May 2.

One of our priorities this school year has been to revise the bylaws of the elementary School Advisory Councils (also known as "School Boards"). The bylaws/guidelines were revised before Christmas. However, we have held off distributing this document due to a series of governance trainings for our pastors. We do not want to overload the pastors, given these trainings and the busy Lenten Season. Our intention is to release the SAC documents closer to the end of the school year, likely after the May 2 Principals' Meeting. Stay tuned for more information!
