

Spring 2025 Terra Nova Precode Labels:

Spring 2025 PreCode Upload window is now open. All uploads must be completed by December 13. Below is the recap that was emailed after the training session on the TerraNova Next Multiple Student Upload process. This process is for both paper testers and online testers. For paper testers, this file will be used to generate your student precode labels (these are used to attach to the student testing documents in lieu of hand bubbling). For online testers, this file adds your students to the portal to prepare for testing.

IMPORTANT:

Outstanding question: When is the last day to manually enter students after the upload is completed? This is if you have students that enroll after you have uploaded your file. For <u>paper testers</u>, the last day to manually add students after your upload is **12/13/24**. For <u>Online testers</u>, the last day to manually add students after your upload is **2/17/25**. <u>Do not upload a second file</u>.

CERTIFICATION:

Please disseminate the following information to your certification coordinators:

Coordinators – please be sure to check teachers' RML transcripts BEFORE submitting the Microsoft form to request certification renewal. Teachers certified in the following areas must have 40 RDG points:

Elementary Education (K-6)

PreK/Primary Education (age 3-3rd grade)

Elementary Education (1-6)

Primary Education (K-3)

Middle Grades English (5-9)

Middle Grades Integrated Curriculum (5-9)

English for Speakers of Other Languages ESOL (K-12)

English (6-12)

Reading (K-12)

English (1-6)

Exceptional Student Education (K-12)

Reading (Endorsement)

Please remind teachers of the process for renewal. There have been several instances recently of teachers receiving deficiency notices because they applied for renewal but did not inform their certification coordinator, so the coordinator did not know to submit the request form to OCS. The process for renewal is as follows:

- 1. Teacher applies for renewal on FDOE website and pays fee.
- 2. Teacher informs certification coordinator that they have applied for renewal.
- 3. Certification coordinator checks transcript in RML to make sure teacher has satisfied all points requirements.
- 4. Certification coordinator submits Microsoft form request to OCS.
- 5. OCS submits points and transcript to FDOE.

EARLY DISMISSAL DAYS:

The month of December includes two Early Dismissal Days. The first day, December 6, should be used for teacher professional development. The second date is Dec. 20 and need not be used for professional development. Schools may schedule social activities on this date or simply release teachers to start their Christmas Break.

FAITH FORWARD INNOVATION CONFERENCE - SESSION PROPOSALS NEEDED:

The Vatican

Pope Francis is calling the faithful worldwide to be "Pilgrims of Hope" in the Jubilee Year 2025, from December 2024 through the end of the Jubilee Year on January 6, 2026.

Cathedrals and Shrines

For pilgrims unable to travel to Rome, Bishops around the world are designating their Cathedrals and/or popular Catholic Shrines as special places of prayer for Jubilee Year 2025 pilgrims, offering opportunities for reconciliation, indulgences, and other events intended to strengthen and revive their faith.

Jubilee Year

A Holy Year, or Jubilee, is a time of pilgrimage, prayer, repentance, and acts of mercy, based on the ancient Jewish tradition of a Jubilee Year of rest, forgiveness, and renewal. Holy years also are a time when Catholics visit designated churches and shrines, recite special prayers, go to confession and receive Communion to receive an indulgence, which is a remission of the temporal punishment due for one's sins.
