High School Dual Enrollment Courses

These courses are taken in grades 7-8 for high school credit

- Algebra I Honors
- Latin I General
- Geometry Honors
- Latin II General
- Spanish II General (will be discontinued after the 2022-2023 school year)

Four credits of Math and two credits of World Language MUST be taken in grades 9-12 at the high school

Content Delivery Options for High School Dual Enrollment Courses

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- \$300 per student, per course
- school enrolls students in the ADOM-VCS SIS
- asynchronous course/learning
- ADOM-VCS provides the teacher
- students must have their own device
- students have direct access to the ADOM-VCS course content (including Final Exams)
- due dates for assignments are determined by ADOM-VCS (including Final Exams)

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- \$150 per student, per course
- school enrolls students in the ADOM-VCS SIS
- schools provide the certified teacher
- school teacher has direct access to ADOM-VCS content, resources, and assessments (including Final Exams)
- school teacher can integrate additional content and resources
- students have direct access to the ADOM-VCS course content (including Final Exams)
- due dates for assignments are determined by school teacher (Final Exam dates are determined by ADOM-VCS)

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- \$75 per student, per course
- school enrolls students in the ADOM-VCS SIS
- schools provide the certified teacher
- school teacher does NOT direct access to ADOM-VCS content, resources, assessments
- students do NOT have direct access to the ADOM-VCS course content
- student has a minimum Terra Nova Score of (for Algebra I H)
- ONLY STUDY GUIDE AND FINAL EXAMS are provided by ADOM-VCS
- students MUST take the ADOM-VCS FINAL EXAMS during pre-scheduled Final Exam Week
