High School Dual Enrollment Courses

These courses are taken in grades 7-8 for high school credit

- Algebra I Honors
- Geometry Honors
- Spanish II General (will be discontinued after the 2022-2023 school year)
- Latin I General
- Latin II General

Four credits of Math and two credits of World Language MUST be taken in grades 9-12 at the high school

- Middle School Critical Thinking, Problem Solving, and Learning Strategies - 1 credit
